



SNOMED CT Licensing of Mobile Applications

Application Development

Development Licenses are free to all mobile application developers. This approach aims to support and encourage the use of SNOMED CT in the mobile applications.

Application Production

- The following license fee costs will apply for mobile applications in production:

Downloads	*License Fee
0 - 100,000	Free
100,000- 250,000	2 % of application retail price
250,000 +	1 % of application retail price

- Note the License Fees for mobile applications are not on an annual basis, as the purchase of mobile applications is done once. Given the fee is based on retail price of application, the fiscal situation of the market will be recognized.

Requirements of the licensee

- 1. Use of SNOMED CT in all applications is as specified in the SNOMED CT Affliliate license available from https://www.snomed.org/snomed-ct/get-snomed
- 2. The licensee will report the Expected coverage globally during the application process.
- 3. The licensee will include an outline of how SNOMED CT will be exposed to the users of the application during the application process.
- 4. The licensee will estimate the retail cost of the Application during the application process.
- 5. The licensee will be required to notify the IHTSDO in writing upon reaching the 100,000 downloads.
- 6. The licensee will be required to report the number of downloads over 100,000 on an annual basis. The Licensee will have 30 days to report the annual number upon which IHTSDO will issue an invoice to the owners payment will be due net 30 days.

- 7. The licensee will be required to report, to the best of their knowledge, where the application has been interfaced to another application as additional license fees may apply.
- 8. Where the licensee plans to deploy an application where a translated extension exists, there are no additional requirements. Where the licensee plans to translate SNOMED CT into a language that does not currently exist in an extension, the licensee must apply to IHTSDO for special permission to translate. Any translation of SNOMED CT would be required to be shared with IHTSDO. The licensee would make the request through info@snomed.org.
